

Minor Waiver Form

For ANYONE going into the pits who is under the age of 18. The form MUST be printed in color and cannot be folded or bent in any way. Forms printed in black, folded/bent, and/or lacking notarization cannot be accepted at the track.

- -BOTH parents MUST sign the form for minor drivers (only one parent for minor crew)
- -Page one is for the parent to complete (print a second copy of page one for the second parent). Page two is for the minor to complete.
- -ALL pages of the form MUST be notarized

Failure to meet any of the requirements (directed by insurance) may result in the driver not being able to compete.

2024 August Slinger Speedway Slamfest Event Rules

ALL GLASS (EXCEPT WINDSHIELD) MUST BE REMOVED BEFORE COMING TO TRACK
SUNROOFS MUST BE REMOVED AND SECURELY REPLACED WITH METAL
Tech mandatory for all entries

Slamfest Rules

- 1. Any 1969 or newer 4 cylinder, 6 cylinder, or 8 cylinder are eligible. Cars, trucks, vans, and SUV's are eligible
- 2. No all-wheel drive vehicles
- 3. Gut all burnable interior items except for drivers and passenger door pad and dashboard.
 - If driver's door pad is removed a cushion or pad must be installed in its place. All airbags must be deactivated.
- 4. All glass must be removed, (expect windshield) prior to entering Slinger Speedway's premises. All cars must have complete glass windshield.
 - If windshield is removed, a screen or Lexan windshield is required.
 - Screen must be no smaller than 1/8" diameter and have 4 evenly space 1"x1"x1/8" thick angle iron used as vertical braces for the windshield Lexan/screen.
 - Remove all exterior headlights and tail lights and any trim pieces.
- 5. All Bumpers must remain stock, but can be reinforced. No nerf bars or pipe of any kind will be allowed for substitution of a stock bumper.
 - All bumpers must be safety chained/cabled to the body so it cannot fall of the car. Loss or dragging of a bumper will result in immediate black flag.
 - Trailer hitches allowed for trailer race only.
- 6. All doors must be welded, chained, or bolted shut. Hood pins and 1" lug nuts strongly recommended.
- 7. Stock seatbelts are required. Racing 4 or 5 point harness is recommended, and must be mounted securely with no less than ½" grade 5 fasteners.
- 8. All cars must have a minimal door to door support bar running from pillar to pillar behind the driver's seat.
 - This will keep the car from crushing. Must be round tubing, min. 1-3/4" OD .095 thickness or greater. No cast iron tubing or water pipes.
 - A single hoop, or 4 point roll cage is recommended, but not required. Interior driver door padding is recommended
 - Cars must be strictly stock. No cutting, chopping, channeling, or shortening allowed. The hood must remain in place at all times.
- BATTERY & RADIATOR: MUST BE UNDER HOOD & SECURELY MOUNTED. NO ANTI-FREEZE. Removed anti-freeze and replace with water
- FUEL TANK: If fuel tank is mounted behind the rear axle, a boat tank or fuel cell must replace the fuel tank. Fuel cell or boat tan must be securely mounted in the trunk with minimum 1" wide by 1/8" thick steel straps, (two straps in each direction), with min. 3/8" hardware. Ruptured or leaking gas tank will lead to an immediate black flag
- FUEL TANK: If fuel tank is mounted behind the rear axle, a boat tank or fuel cell must replace the fuel tank
- Fuel cell or boat tan must be securely mounted in the trunk with minimum 1" wide by 1/8" thick steel straps, (two straps in each direction),
- with min. 3/8" hardware.
- Ruptured or leaking gas tank will lead to an immediate black flag.
- TIRES: passenger car tires or racing tires only. No studded tires of any kind will be allowed.
- ENGINE: The engine must be strictly stock for that year, model, and make. Engine must be in its stock location, using stock mounts
- CARBURETOR: No dual line double pumpers. One 2bbl or ONE 4bbl carb only
- EXHAUST: Exhaust must exit underneath car, behind the driver
- Safety Gear must be kept on during race event until you exit track.
- HELMET: 2010 or newer helmet only.
- . Must wear long pants and long sleeves, no shorts. Gloves and neck brace are strongly recommended.
- CAR APPERANCE: Attractive and themed cars, trucks, vans, and school buses encouraged.
 - LARGE/BOLD clearly readable numbers on both sides of the vehicle required for scoring and payment.
- •Slinger Super Speedway reserves the right to make rule adjustments at any time to maintain safe and competitive racing.
- •Burn outs on the infield Slinger Speedway logo will lead to disqualification, no payouts for any races and forfeiture of entry fees paid by yourself and pit crew.
- No consumption of alcohol prior to or during events you are racing in.
- Alcohol consumption prior to or during race events you have entered will lead to disqualification and forfeiture of entry fees paid by yourself and pit crew.
- Drivers are responsible for the conduct of all crew members!
- NO 2-way Radios Cell phones, or GoPro's (any type of recording device), in the car during the events

Events

B-TRACK Barrel RACE

- 14 car minimum.
- 5 lap race. Cars race around the Slinger Speedway Oval using the B track.
- Entering the infield off turn 2, turning right at the X then re-entering the track at turn 3.
- Must do 1 full revolution around the Barrel in the X each lap.

BURN OUT CONTEST (first 12 entered)

- Hubcaps must be removed.
- Water only, no chemicals.
- Street Legal Cars Welcome.
- Fans Judge.

SCHOOL BUS FIGURE 8

- 8 bus minimum, 10 lap race.
- All Glass must be removed except windshield.
- Mandatory Seat Belt (Five point harness are highly recommended).

BIG CAR FIGURE 8

- 14 car minimum.
- 6 & 8 cylinder cars.
- 15 lap feature no qualifying race.
- Use of local track rules or Slinger Super Speedway rules is acceptable No driver door hits

GAUNTLET


- 10 Slamfest vehicles will be used for this event
- First 10 pre-registered participants only
- 4 and 6 cylinder only
- NO Trucks, Full Size SUV's, Full Size Vans or Jeeps

LITTLE SWITZERLAND SKI RACING

- **NOTICE** SKIS that are NOT to correct specifications will be disqualified, NO REFUNDS will be issued
- **NOTICE** Black flagged cars that do move off track will be disqualified, NO PAY.
- 5 lap race
- Must be front wheel drive car with "skis" in place of the rear wheels. Ski spec is shown with pictures of sample ski including length, width, and thickness of ski
- . A bumper (impact bar) may also be used as a ski. New style bumpers are hollow and work well for this application

The ends of the ski must be curved up, most bumpers are formed in this fashion If they are not curved

If you use a piece of steel plate the ends must be curved up so they don't dig into asphalt



- Emergency brake must be activated to keep rear wheel from extra load and potentially turning.
- You will be black flagged if a ski falls off and must leave the track.
- Skis that are not to correct specifications will be disqualified, no refunds will be issued

PRETZEL RACE

- 6 laps (4 for heat races if needed)
- Start at start finish line on front stretch go thru turn 1 and out of turn 2 turn left into X
- At the X turn left to go back towards turn 1 and proceed thru 1,2 and the back stretch
- Go into 3 and out of turn 4 left into the X
- . Then at the X turn left to proceed back into 3 and thru 4 back to the start finish line on the front stretch which would complete your lap



TRAILER/FLOAT RACE

- Winner gets a trophy.
- PRE-ENTRY ONLY. First 18 entries will race.
- · Starting position designated by entry date.
- ALL the trailers in the trailer race will be themed.
- Fans will vote to determine the winner with the best entry.
- The best trailer picked by the fans will win an extra \$100.00.
- . No dual axle trailers. Single axle trailers ONLY.
- No Boats
- NO PINTLE Hitches. MUST BE REGULAR BALL HITCH NO EXTRA ATTACHMENTS...PERIOD!
- Trailer can be connected by the hitch only, NO chains or sway bars.
- If trailer is dragging, you will get the Move-Over flag to stay off of the racing surface. Failure to do so will be a DQ with NO PRIZE MONEY
- When the trailer is lost or is deemed to be unsafe (flat tire, etc.) that trailer is out of the race
- Door bars strongly recommended for trailer race tow vehicles
- Camper trailers MUST BE 100% GUTTED if not will be disqualified, NO REFUNDS will be issued
- Trailer hits only, Disqualification for direct vehicle hit NO PAY
- Blue Move Over Flag will be given (and hit with paintballs to alert them) for vehicles with flat tires that may be damaging track,

failure to stay off the regular racing surface in the corners will result in a Disqualification and NO PAY

• Black flagged cars will also be hit with paintballs in the windshield to help notify the driver

Whoop -dee-do (similar to B-Track Barrel Race)

- 14 car minimum.
- 5 lap race.
- Cars race around the Slinger Speedway Oval using the B track.
- Enter front stretch X out of turn 4 go around barrel exit X into turn 1 (must do 1 full revolution)
- Back stretch enter X off of turn 2 exit into turn 3 (do not go around barrel)

BACK UP PUSH CAR RACE

- Six 2-car team minimum.
- Driver 1 of the of the push car race car must to fill out an entry form for both drivers.
- Both cars will drive backwards.
- The object of this race is to push a disabled car around the track
- Six 2 car teams race from a standing start for 4 laps.
- Top two will advance to the 6 lap feature race.
- The car being pushed must be disabled so the engine cannot run during the race.
- . If engine is till functional battery must be removed or disconnected. The engine can be removed if desired but it's not necessary
- Cars race around the Slinger Speedway Oval.
