The Sunday Night Tradition


Once you experience racing action at Slinger Speedway, you will understand why the World's Fastest Quarter Mile Asphalt Oval is celebrating over 61 years of racing.

Dating back to the opening of the track in 1948, the speedway has been a breeding ground for racings rising stars. With the help of Wayne Erickson, track owner Rollie Heder decided the track was in need of a serious transformation. Slinger Super Speedway was born in 1974 as a high banked asphalt oval. Erickson was no stranger to auto racing, as he had been involved with the sport since 1963.

In 1976 Erickson purchased the track from Heder and brought a fresh spirit of competition that attracted media, drivers and fans from coast to coast. Erickson also believed

in creating the maximum fan experience and added many special promotions. The track has grown tremendously in the past 50 years and has evolved into a premier motorsports facility.

•The beginning... 1939, Bill Johnson Sr. graded a small track in his backyard.

> 1947 fellow race drivers and fans regularly gathered at Billy's to race.

> > •Wed, July 10, 1948, Bill Johnson Sr. and Rollie Heder joined forces for the first official race show. 5000 race fans attended.

•Slinger Speedways original race cars were Midgets.

- •The first stock cars were introduced to Slinger in 1949.
- •July 27, 1950 the show moved to Sunday nights.

•1958 & 1959 race cars shed their heavy bodies and took on the open wheeled look of today's modifieds.

•1974, after 27 years as a dirt track Rollie and Wayne Erickson turned Slinger

Speedway into a 33° banked asphalt track.

•1974 the winged modifieds were the first to take on the steep asphalt banks.

• July 22 & 23, 1974 the Late Models made their first appearance at Slinger.

- •1976 Wayne Erickson purchased track from Rollie Heder.
- •1978, 79 Allen Kulwicki was Slinger Late Model champion.
- •June 10, 1980 the first SLINGER NATIONALS were held.



- 1980's VIP Suite #1 was built to accommodate race sponsors and fans.
 - •1990 Matt Kenseth was Rookie-of-the-Year at Slinger.
 - •1991 VIP Pavilion was built on the south end of the track.
 - 1994 the track was repayed.
- June 12, 1994, Tony Strupp set the record for the fastest 1/4 mile, running 11.095 sec. This impressive record is yet to be beat in 2006.
- 1998 main office building was built.
- 2000 VIPPavilion was updated.
- •2001 the main grand stand area was redone, (the original built in the 1940's).
- •2003 the corners of the race track were reground for better performance.
- 2004, VIP Suite #2 was added.
- •2005, the back pits were paved.
- •2006, Slinger Speedway celebrated 30 years of Wayne Erickson promoting track. Plus a fan center was built.
- 2007 Slinger Speedway celebrated it's 60th Anniversary!
- •2008 USAC Midget Cars set world record fast time! We added a go-kart track!





The future of Slinger Super Speedway will surely bring new milestones to racing competition, and one thing is for certain, the Sunday night tradition that was established July 27, 1950, will continue far into the future

OMPETITION

LATE MODEL

The Slinger Late Model Division is our premier division. These V-8 cars are the fastest short



track cars you will see in the world. The Aluminum and fiberglass body cars have exotic racing engines. These cars are built from the ground up, as racing machines. Late Model cars turns laps here in just over 11 seconds. It is these cars, which have established the world record lap speeds on a quarter-mile paved oval.

LIMITED LATE MODEL

These cars have a lightweight tubular steel chassis with racing components throughout, and



a 425hp engine. Limiteds are purpose-built race cars that allow for unlimited chassis adjustability. There are limits as to the amount of money that can be spent on components, making the Limiteds class perfect for the serious, cost-conscious racer.

MIDWEST MODIFIED

This division is a descendent of I.M.C.A modified. The car has a stock car frame, (usually a 76-88 G.M.), uses



factory suspension parts. Running a more centrally re-located V-8 motor, these relatively in expensive cars have flat aluminum body panels with their 8" wide tires protruding from its body. Capable of laps in the 12 second range, these cars are loud, listen for them thundering around and your adrenaline will start.

MIDWEST SPORTSMAN

The Midwest Sportsman cars are a stepping stone to the more powerful Midwest Modified and Late Model



divisions. The division sets up the driver for learning the basic rules, techniques of car set-up and a fun way to race on a working mans budget. Exciting action is what this division provides.

FIGURE-8

The Figure 8 division is a one race per night class that follows a figure eight pattern. When the average 10-car field



starts to get strung out, the leader begins to encounter the other cars at intersection. That's when you hold your breath and see who will make it through the fast paced event. The cars vary from older race cars to any type of American car.

Thunderstocks

These race cars are very affordable and meant to prepare drivers for the more prestigious divisions and help them get



accustomed to the track and the rules. There is no model newer than 1992. The makes are Chevy, Ford or Chrysler. This division is a fun and more economical way to try racing on the high banks of Slinger Super Speedway.

SLINGER BEE

Possibly the most affordable way to test the high banks of Slinger Super Speedway is the Bees division. These basic four-cylinder cars are



inexpensive to prepare and race. The cars are almost stock from the factory, with the only modifications allowed for safety.

SPECTATOR RACES

This race division is for the novice driver only, driving street cars. Cars race two-up, single elimination. Any and all types of makes and models race here.

GUEST CARS

The speedway has seven vehicles for rent, so fans can try their luck on the world's fastest 1/4-mile oval. These 7 cars run a 6 lap race to the checkered flag.


